Summary Reports issued June 18

**Tuition:** \$850 (Siblings: \$500) Tuition includes all texts, art supplies, and enrichment materials.

Additional discount applied if registered in the Friday Montessori programme:  
\$600 (Siblings: \$400)

**Class size:** Classes are divided into Grades 1-3 and Grades 4-6 with 8 students maximum

**Uniform:** The school uniform consists of a red polo shirt with beige pants for boys, and a navy polo shirt with a beige skirt and navy socks or tights for girls.
